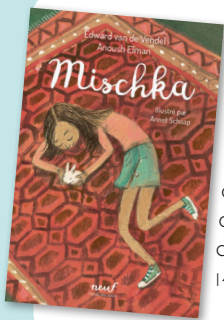


## JANUARY 2027
